

## **DESCRIPTION:**

Talaris, the manufacturer of the MiniMech dispenser, has approved the use of the MiniMech (and MultiMech) without the Teflon strips found on each side of the bay where the cassette rests. Talaris will no longer produce the dispensers with these strips.

Extensive testing verified that the dispenser will operate successfully without the Teflon strips with minimal wear. This change will eliminate the issue of the Teflon strip peeling off which leaves a sticky residue. If any of these strips are found peeling, feel free to remove them and their sticky residue completely. Whenever removing one strip, always remove the other.
