DESCRIPTION:

Triton announces the side and height adjustments required for HCDU cassettes to properly dispense Canadian Polymer notes. Perform the following steps to adjust the cassette from the US settings to Canadian settings.


No additional parts are required to make this adjustment however a #1 Phillips screwdriver will be needed.

Step 1 – Unlock and open the cassette that needs adjusting.






Step 2 – Loosen, DO NOT REMOVE, the two screws securing the right side rail.



Step 3 – Slide the rail to the left as far as it will go and tighten the screws.






Step 4 – Remove the two screws securing the right height adjuster bar.



Step 5 – Turn the height adjuster bar around.









Step 6 – Reinstall the previously removed screws to secure the right height adjuster bar. Repeat Step 4 – 6 for the for the left side height adjuster. Ensure the bottoms of the height adjusters are even (yellow line).



Step 7 – The cassette is now ready for Canadian Polymer note dispense.
