## SUBJECT: MULTITECH MODEM PARAMETERS



#### **RECOMMENDED - RECONFIGURE MODEM PARAMETERS**

MultiTech changed the default error control and synchronous mode parameter from 1 to 3. Triton has discovered that this can cause a failure to communicate with Triton Connect when using a Systech modem. Any 81XX/91XX /96XX/97XX ATM equipped with a MultiTech MT56XXSMI modem series with B/O: 34 version should change the initialization string for Triton Connect to +ES=1 to avoid communication issues. Verify modem model, then follow steps below to configure.



- 1. Navigate to *Management Functions* > *Configure Terminal* > *More* > *Communication* > *Modem Configuration* > *Modem Setup String* > *Triton Connect Call String*.
- 2. Select **Change**. Terminal will not visually prompt user that it is ready for input.
- 3. Enter the value: **+ES=1**.
- 4. Press **Enter** on the keypad to complete configuration.
