**This Technical Tip references the USB Cable to EPP Power at the Triton's ATMGurus Website**

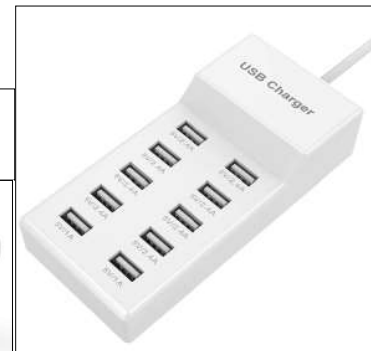
### **\*\*NOTE\*\***

**THIS DOES NOT CHARGE THE BATTERY. THE BATTERY IS NOT RE-CHARGEABLE.**

1. This cable (09120-00988) and wall charger (not included) provide power to the keypad instead of using the battery, prolonging the life of the battery. This is useful for keypads not installed in an ATM or keypads installed in an unpowered ATM.
2. Cable requires a wall charger (not included) with USB-A connector, single or multiport, see images below.

### **How to Use:**

#### **If EPP is not installed:**

3. Plug RJ45 on (09120-00988) cable into EPP.
4. Plug USB-A connector into wall charger.
5. Plug charger into wall outlet.

#### **If EPP is installed in unit:**

1. Unplug ATM EPP power cable.
2. Plug RJ45 on (09120-00988) cable into EPP.
3. Plug USB-A connector into wall charger.
4. Plug charger into wall outlet. If extension cord used, can leave extension cord in top of ATM.

#### **When properly powered with above cable:**

**After 2-4 seconds, you should see:**

- | <b>Keypad:</b> | <b>LEDs:</b>   |
|----------------|----------------|
| • T5, T9, T10  | Green blinking |
