****NOTE****

THIS DOES NOT CHARGE THE BATTERY. THE BATTERY IS NOT RE-CHARGEABLE.

1. The EPP Power Keeper kits contain 10x EPP Storage Power Cable and one USB Power Source Module
2. This provides power to the keypad instead of using the battery, thus prolonging the life of the battery.
3. Kits applies to the keypads listed below the kit's part number.

How to Use:

If EPP is not installed

1. Plug kit cable connector into the EPP.
2. Plug USB-A connector into the USB Power Source Module.
3. Plug the AC power cord into the module, then into a wall outlet.

If EPP is installed in the ATM

1. Unplug ATM EPP power cable.
2. Plug kit cable connector into the EPP.
3. Plug USB-A connector into the USB Power Source Module.
4. Plug the AC power cord into the module, then into a wall outlet.

5. Cable applies to the keypads listed below the cable's part number.

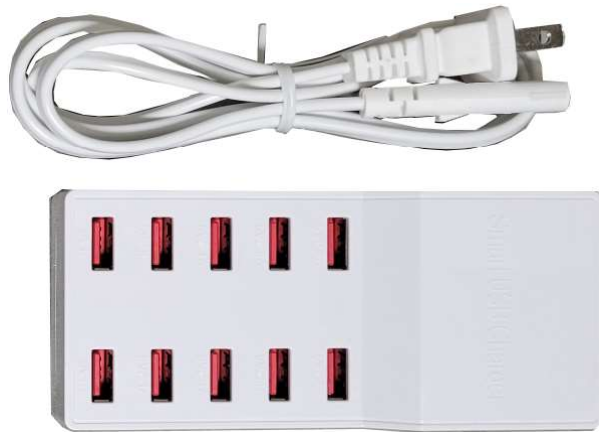

How to Use:

If EPP is not installed

1. Plug specific cable for your keypad into the EPP.
2. Plug USB-A connector into the USB Power Source Module.
3. Plug the AC power cord into the module, then into a wall outlet.

If EPP is installed in the ATM

1. Unplug ATM EPP power cable.
2. Plug specific cable for your keypad into the EPP.
3. Plug USB-A connector into the USB Power Source Module.
4. Plug the AC power cord into the module, then into a wall outlet.

It is acceptable to leave wall charger in top of ATM.
