Release of the CDM8240N Dispenser for US and Canada X4 Mainboard Software Version 5.1

Triton announces the release of the CDM8240N dispenser option for the ARGO FT. The customer can order either the NMD100 or CDM8240N dispenser in their new ATM. The CDM8240N dispenser option requires the X4 mainboard hardware, and terminal software version 5.1. X4 requires Triton Connect version 6.3.
